It's been an awesome summer so far! We have been to Joplin, Missouri and to the Dreamcenter in Los Angeles. Both trips were eye-opening and a blessing as we were forced to see beyond ourselves and reach out to others.

The devastation in Joplin was widespread and many families were displaced. We volunteered at a church that was essentially the headquarters for all the relief efforts in the state. Federal and State aid was being directed to this church in Joplin as they were coordinating the efforts to help families that survived the tornado.

In Los Angeles, we stayed for a week at the Dreamcenter. While 200 ministries operate out of the Dreamcenter, three ministries had a lasting impact on our ministry team: The Jonah Project, Under the Bridge, and the Food Truck. The Jonah Project is located on Skid Row in Los Angeles. It is a rescue mission that daily ministers to the homeless that line the blocks of Skid Row in the thousands. Under the Bridge is also a Skid Row ministry that helps feed the homeless everyday. The Food Truck delivers groceries to the neighborhoods surrounding the Dreamcenter. We loved being there so much; we are going again in 2013!

The ministry is in the final stage of receiving 501(c)(3) status from the IRS. This last stage is the largest so be in prayer for the leadership that we stick with it! (Paperwork can be very depressing!)

We have been able to meet needs in the church as well as outside the church thanks to our volunteers and our family at Lighthouse Christian Fellowship, our home.
